Campsite Application Guidelines

APRIL SCHOOL HOLIDAYS INCLUDING EASTER 2017

The following information should be read in conjunction with the Site Description & Equipment Limits and the Croajingolong Park Notes which can be accessed at www.pointhicks.com.au The following information will assist you in completing your application form.

- Applications for campsites will only be processed if they are received by mail on the form below.
- Applications will be processed in order of receipt commencing on the 1st FEBRUARY 2017. Early applications will be deemed to have arrived on that day and be processed accordingly.
- The booking periods extend from 10am on the day of arrival until 10am on the day of departure.
- Only one site may be applied for on each application form. Multiple applications should be sent in one envelope if you wish to camp as a group with others- same time or close locations.
- A maximum of 6 people over the age of 3 years are permitted on any one site
- Refer to the Site Description & Equipment Limits document when making your selection. **Vehicle limits** will be enforced and where permitted a second vehicle must be paid for with the application.
- Payment is required in full, in advance and must be sent with your campsite application form. If you are claiming a concessional rate please include a copy of your relevant concession card. Payment may be made by cheque or money order. **Cheques must be made payable to KRR Services Pty Ltd.**
- Enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope with your application for return of your camping advice and receipt.
- You may specify an alternative campground, alternative campsites or alternative weeks. Please only include these if you are willing to accept them.
- If your application is unsuccessful, your payment will be fully refunded. However once a campsite is allocated there will be absolutely no refunds.
- Firewood is not included in your campsite fee but can be purchased from the campsite management, or you can bring your own. The cost of firewood has increased substantially due to increasing supplier costs. **It is illegal to collect wood from the camping area or anywhere else in the Croajingolong National Park.**
- Some campsites especially at the Mueller Inlet, are subject to flooding and may be closed. Control of inlet levels is entirely a matter for Parks Victoria. KRR will attempt to offer alternative campsites for any affected campers where possible and refund camping fees where it is not.

- Maximum of **SIX** people/site (over the age of 3).
